



## 2018: The Seventh Year - Open Doors

### Theme of Open Doors

This year emphasized that "open doors" are not just for blessings but a call for the Church to open the doors of their hearts to let Jesus reign as King, addressing divisions and self-serving agendas within Christianity.

### "Jesus Reigns" Bibles

A significant initiative involved commissioning the printing of Bibles (Cebuano and Tagalog) with the "Jesus Reigns" logo, reinforcing the message that the entire Bible points to Jesus' reign.



### Global Expansion Continues

"Jesus Reigns" reached new prefectures in Japan (Fukushima and Nagano) and Honolulu, Hawaii, USA.

### Prophetic Tours in Israel

Prophetic tours to Israel became a regular feature, with acts like unfurling flags of nations at significant sites (e.g., Temple Mount, "Gates of Hell" in Banias) and planting trees, signifying spiritual warfare and the birthing of Jews into the spiritual family.

# What is Jesus Reigns?



At its heart, Jesus Reigns is about unity within the body of Christ. It brings together diverse churches and denominations, overcoming the usual divides of culture and doctrine. How? By simply laying down secondary concerns and focusing on the unparalleled worthiness of Christ. When Jesus is lifted high, He draws everyone to Himself (John 12:32), creating a bond among believers across provinces like never before.

Every year, on November 30, Jesus Reigns transforms into a vibrant simultaneous celebration across the Philippines. Believers from all 83 provinces gather in their respective locations as one to honor the Reign of King Jesus and declare His Lordship. This isn't just a traditional festivity; it's an explosive spirit-filled display of worship from hearts consumed by the vision of seeing Jesus reign in our beloved nation.



Jesus Reigns is a national movement in the Philippines with one clear purpose: exalting the name of Jesus as the rightful King over our nation. These two words have become a bold cry for Christians across our islands. It's a proclamation of God's ultimate victory through Jesus, the name supreme above all powers, dominions, thrones, and principalities. When believers declare "Jesus Reigns!", we join a heavenly chorus, exalting God's beloved Son.

## 2016: The Fifth Year - Harvest

### Japan Celebration

On August 15, 2016 (a significant day of surrender for Japan in WWII), Japan held its first "Jesus Reigns" celebration in Tokyo with nearly 1,000 attendees, declaring their surrender to Jesus.

### Indonesia Joins

Indonesia held its first "Jesus Reigns" celebration in Surabaya on October 1, 2016, demonstrating faith in a Muslim-majority nation and experiencing miracles.



## 2017: The Sixth Year - Total Surrender

### Theme of Total Surrender

The theme emphasized dying to oneself (John 12:24) for genuine revival and the unity of the Body of Christ, stressing that true worship is not about outward show but a surrendered heart.

### Washing of Feet

The Vision-Keeper and her husband, in a powerful act of humility and obedience, washed the feet of key leaders and provincial coordinators at the Summit, signifying total surrender and paving the way for greater breakthrough and harvest.



### International Reach

The movement continued its global expansion with the first "Jesus Reigns" pre-celebration in Kawai, Hawaii, USA.



## Unprecedented Unity

Despite one province not pushing through, 81 provinces simultaneously held "Jesus Reigns" celebrations on November 30, 2014. Testimonies from Ilocos Norte, Iloilo, and Misamis Oriental highlighted unprecedented unity, large turnouts, and divine intervention.

## Global Vision

The Vision-Keeper received an impression that God desires every nation to celebrate "Jesus Reigns," envisioning a "red carpet" for Jesus' second coming.

## 2015: The Fourth Year - Consecration

### Theme of Consecration

The theme for 2015 was "Consecration," symbolizing the Church breaking down the "altars of their hearts."

### Israel Encounter

During a trip to Israel for the Feast of Tabernacles, the Vision-Keeper's husband experienced a critical heart attack. His miraculous recovery and a subsequent spiritual encounter were seen as a "literal experience of the consecration of the heart" and a symbolic connection of the Gentile Church to the Messianic Church.



## Sulu Joins

Sulu province, recognized as one of the most dangerous Muslim-majority provinces, joined the celebration, making it 82 out of 82 provinces simultaneously enthrone Jesus for the first time in Philippine history. This marked a significant breakthrough in a region often associated with conflict and religious divides.

## International Connection

A Japanese pastor, Pastor Kakuko Shigeeda, whom the Vision-Keeper met in Hong Kong, brought a delegation to the Cebu celebration, leading to the commitment of "Jesus Reigns Japan."

## Japan's Apology

Pastor Kakuko publicly asked for forgiveness, on behalf of Japan, for actions during World War II, symbolizing a significant breakthrough in reconciliation between the two nations.

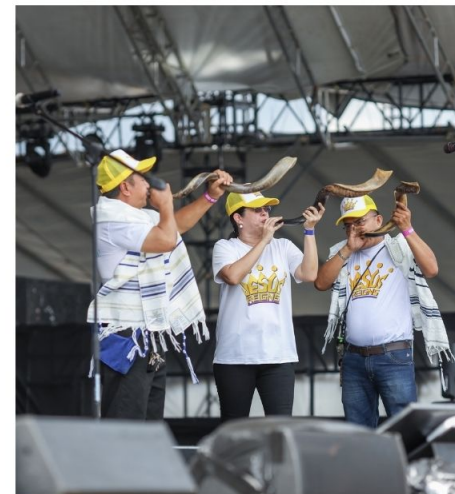


# Our Purpose



## Vision

To see every nation consumed by the love of the Heavenly Father, empowered by the Holy Spirit, seeking to honor God and worship Jesus Christ alone, and to exalt the name of Jesus in righteous living as one body for individual restoration and national transformation.



## Mission

### 3 UNITY

It is God's intention for the Body of Christ to work together. As members, we need each other to achieve greater things for the glory of God's kingdom.

For there is one Body and one Spirit, just as you have been called to one glorious hope for the future. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God and Father of all, who is over all, in all, and living through all." – Ephesians 4:3-6

In giving to the Lord, we challenge everyone involved in the movement, men and women, churches, and establishments, to commit their time, talent, and resources sacrificially, without expecting anything in return.

## Vision-Casting & Organizing

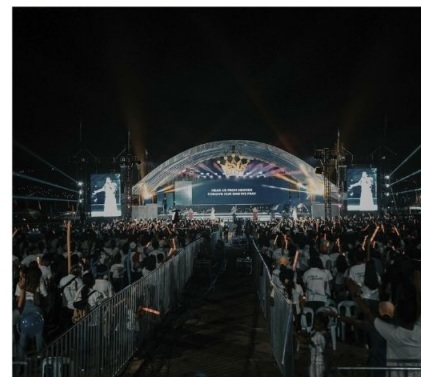
Meetings were held in Manila (Luzon) and General Santos City (Mindanao) with Christian leaders, who embraced the vision, leading to the formation of organizing teams for each major island group.

## Anointing the Nation

On November 30, 2013, the entire Philippines was anointed from the sky with oil, representing a spiritual battle for the nation. Miraculous appearances of rainbows confirmed God's approval and covenant.

## Simultaneous Celebrations

Celebrations took place simultaneously in Tondo, Manila (Luzon), Oval Plaza, General Santos City (Mindanao), and in Cebu City (Visayas). Mindanao reported "a little heaven down here" with 35,000 attendees and miraculous parting of clouds during the event.



## 2014: The Third Year - Festival of 82 Provinces



## Province-Wide Challenge

The Lord challenged the movement to hold simultaneous "Jesus Reigns" celebrations in all 82 provinces of the Philippines. This challenge was given through God's Word in Exodus 5:1 (NIV), where it states, "Afterward Moses and Aaron went to Pharaoh and said, 'This is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'Let My people go, so that they may hold a festival to Me in the wilderness.'"

## Prophetic Acts

82 palm oil trees were planted in Mt. Moriah, Cebu, representing the provinces, and palm-leaf-designed kites were flown, symbolically "shooting the enemy." The Philippine flag was prophetically baptized in the Jordan River, signifying a declaration of war against the enemy in the spirit realm over the nation.





## Day of Celebration and Breakthrough:

On November 30, 2012, the first "Jesus Reigns" celebration culminated in Cebu City, drawing an impressive crowd of around 15,000 people. The event commenced with a grand parade, where participants carried colorful banners representing the towns and cities of Cebu, alongside streamers proclaiming the various Names of Jesus. This was followed by unified prayer and intercession for the entire province, leading into an "Extravagant Worship" night. The celebration was marked by a great harvest of souls, signifying numerous individuals giving their lives to Christ, and fostered strong unity among the participating churches. The evening concluded with a majestic fireworks display, visually exalting Jesus' attributes, as participants departed with hearts overflowing with joy, looking forward to the next year.



## 2013: The Second Year - Luzon, Visayas, Mindanao

### National Expansion

God instructed the Vision-Keeper to expand "Jesus Reigns" to Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao. This instruction was confirmed by God's Word, particularly a passage from Jeremiah stating, "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you; I appointed you a prophet to the nations" (Jeremiah 1:5 NIV), and 1 Peter 2:9 (NIV), which says, "But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God's special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light." Additionally, the passage in Ezekiel 37:1-14 describing the valley of dry bones, was given by the Lord as a sign for the call to the nation. This expansion was a significant leap of faith, confirmed by biblical verses and answered prayers, especially regarding her husband's full commitment.

# The 5 core TENETS

## 1 ONE GOD, THREE PERSONS

There is one God, the God of Israel. Deuteronomy 6:4 states, "Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one." Then Jesus introduced us to the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit (Matthew 28:19). Paul also mentions these three Persons in his benedictory prayer (2 Corinthians 13:14).

## 4 SAVED BY GRACE THROUGH FAITH

Salvation is possible by grace through faith (Ephesians 2:8-9). Genuine faith in Jesus activates this grace (Romans 5:1-2). However, faith without works is dead and doesn't lead to true change (James 2:17; Matthew 7:21).



## 2 THE DEITY OF CHRIST

Jesus Christ is fully man and fully God. John 1:1, 14 declares Him as the Word who "became flesh and dwelt among us." Jesus forgives sins, a divine act (Mark 2:5-7), and He accepted worship, which only God deserves (Matthew 14:33; John 9:38).

## 3 THE AUTHORITY OF SCRIPTURE

The Bible is the very Word of God (2 Timothy 3:16-17). It is the final and only authority that governs the Church (Isaiah 8:20; Acts 17:11). It is also the lifeline of every believer (Matthew 4:4; Psalm 119:105).

## 5 LIFE AFTER DEATH

Jesus died and rose again to give us eternal life (1 Corinthians 15:3-4). He is coming back, just as He promised (Acts 1:11). When He returns, He will judge, and people will go to either heaven or hell (John 5:28-29; Matthew 25:46).







# JESUS REIGNS HISTORY

The "Jesus Reigns" movement, originating in Cebu, Philippines, grew from a personal vision into a nationwide and eventually international phenomenon, driven by the core principle of uniting the Body of Christ to exalt Jesus as the reigning King.

## The Vision (Genesis):

The movement began with the "Vision-Keeper" (whose identity remains anonymous to keep the focus on Jesus), a new believer since 1998, who felt a deep desire for God and the unity of the Church in the Philippines. Inspired by a video showing the spiritual revival in Columbia, Fiji, and Guatemala through prayer and unity, she fervently prayed for similar transformation in her own nation. This led to the formation of a prayer group, which grew over seven years, preparing her for a larger calling.

On New Year's Eve 2011, a musing about fireworks bursting into the Name of Jesus planted a seed. On January 1, 2012, she received a clear vision: a multitude of people marching with colorful banners of Cebu towns and cities alongside streamers with the Names of God, culminating in an outdoor worship concert with extravagant fireworks highlighting Jesus' attributes. This vision became the foundation of "Jesus Reigns." The name "Jesus Reigns!" was impressed upon her by the Lord, supported by Psalm 47:8-9, signifying Jesus' reign over nations and the overthrow of Satan. The chosen date, November 30 (Bonifacio Day in the Philippines), symbolically represents spiritual revolution against sin and idolatry.



## Key Developments Year by Year:

### 2012: The First Year - Cebu's Breakthrough

#### Initial Steps and Divine Confirmation:

God's Word in Isaiah 43:18-19 (NIV), which states, "Forget the former things; See I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? I am making a way in the wilderness and streams in the wasteland," confirmed the vision, empowering the Vision-Keeper. She then gathered over 200 pastors in Cebu, who, despite some initial skepticism, came to embrace the vision as a God-given mandate. Initially, her husband harbored reluctance regarding this massive undertaking, but God intervened, performing a specific act that fully gained his support for his wife, the Vision-Keeper, solidifying their united front for the movement. This divine intervention in her husband's heart was likened to God making Joseph understand that the baby inside Mary's womb was of the Holy Spirit.

#### Prophetic Anointing of Cebu

Following God's instruction, a week before the November 30 celebration, Cebu province underwent a significant prophetic act. Oil was anointed from a rented aircraft for seven consecutive days. This act symbolized the spiritual reclaiming of the land for God's purposes and was a declaration of spiritual warfare over the province.
